
Contra Costa County has a balanced budget of \$5.515 billion in expenditures and revenues for all funds and districts

- CORE Mobile Outreach Teams have expanded their hours to 8 am to Midnight – 7 days a week
- CORE teams serve as an entry point into Contra Costa's coordinated entry system
