Public Safety, Infrastructure, Accessibility Strategic Objective

- Develop a city-wide improved pedestrian accessibility plan that includes general pedestrian and roadway safety (striping/repaving/bicycle lanes), safety around schools, and ADA improvements
- Create a comprehensive Maintenance and Repair strategy with mapping and a timeline that identifies where the work/repairs need to be done and costs for completion

Background - The primary focus was on the Clayton Community Park and whether associated improvements could be considered including lighting for ball fields, pickle ball courts, swimming pools, and “community center” space. The secondary focus was related recreation programs and facilities related to youth/senior programs. Typically, these are handled by a Parks & Recreation Department which Clayton does not have or fund.
