



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Executive summary: Tariffs not enough to derail strong momentum?

Macroeconomic outlook

- **Base case:** Policy uncertainty and the imposition of some tariffs are among our 2025 base case expectations. We believe a robust economic environment and earnings backdrop should be enough to power real GDP and markets higher.
- **Growth:** Economic growth in the US should remain driven primarily by consumer spending, which is supported by continued real income growth and strong household balance sheets.
- **Inflation:** While inflation has cooled significantly since 2022, core readings of inflation have stayed stubbornly close to 3%, higher than where the Fed would prefer. This could also reaccelerate if inflationary policies like tariffs come to fruition.
- **Rates:** We expect the Fed to cut rates by 50bps in 2025 to end the year at 4%. A sudden rise in layoffs could trigger more aggressive easing, while the Fed could stay on hold if progress on inflation stalls.

Market overview

- The return of policy volatility: The second Trump term began with announcement of tariffs on Canada, Mexico, and China, with additional levies on the euro area expected. Market reactions have been sanguine so far, helped by last-minute announcements like the one-month delay on Canadian and Mexican tariffs, but expect volatility to remain elevated.
- Markets begin 2025 with a cautiously optimistic tone: The post-election market rally has stalled as investors brace for more volatility and a Federal Reserve that is more reluctant to cut rates in the face of stronger-than-expected data and the continuation of an above-target inflation pace.
- **Focus on the positives:** While tariffs, higher-for-longer rates, and further geopolitical concerns have the potential to derail markets, there are many positives that investors should continue to focus on: A resilient economy, a friendly regulatory environment under President Trump, and the productivity-enhancing benefits of Al.

Investment outlook

- A positive bias toward risk assets favoring equities, which we rate as Attractive. Moderating but solid growth, continued disinflation, and lower rates are all supportive for our Attractive asset classes.
- **Preferences:** We expect positive returns across most asset classes over the next six to 12 months but see particular value in stocks and US equities specifically, which we rate as Attractive.
- **Equities:** Current valuations are high in absolute terms but reasonable when considering strong earnings growth and the macro environment. Historically, when the Fed is cutting rates in the context of a soft landing, equities tend to perform well in 12 months before and after the first Fed rate cut. Tech stocks are most attractive because the Al tailwind has room to run.
- **Credit:** Absolute yields are elevated, while spreads are vulnerable to widening in our downside scenario, favoring high-quality bonds (i.e., IG, MBS).
